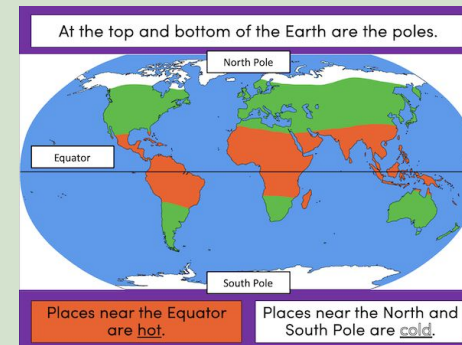

Key Vocabulary

weather patterns	Occurs when the weather stays the same for days or weeks at a time.
seasons	The year is divided into four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
climate	The usual weather conditions of an area.
equator	An imaginary line around the middle of Earth. It is halfway between the North and South Poles.
location	A particular place or position.
weather forecast	A prediction of what the weather will be like in the future
temperature	A measure of how hot or cold something is
