This year at Western House Academy we have received a funding of £21,380 during this academic year.

2. increasing engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity and sporting activities
3. raising the profile of PE and sport across the school, to support whole school improvement
4. offer a broader and more equal experience of a range of sports and physical activities to all pupils
5. increasing participation in competitive sport
