Jigsaw: Drugs, exploitation, gangs, emotional and mental health, managing stress and pressure.

CORE LEARNING:

Reading: Ghost – neglect, achieving goals, transition

SCIENCE: The Art of Being Human – drugs, alcohol, healthy body, diet, lifestyle and exercise

PBL:
